

Official Rules for the “My NYC Song” Teen Songwriting Contest

This competition seeks new songs by New York City teens that tell a story featuring New York City as a topic, a setting, a character or a catalyst. One winner will be invited to perform the winning song at Guitar Mash at City Winery and up to two finalists will receive studio and recording time.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW. ELIGIBLE MINORS MUST OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM THEIR PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THIS CONTEST.

By submitting an entry to the “My NYC Song” Teen Songwriting Contest, you are agreeing to be bound by the following legal terms (“Official Rules”).

1. **ENTRY PERIOD:** The “My NYC Song” Teen Songwriting Contest (the "Competition") will begin at 7:00:00 AM Eastern Standard Time ("EST") August 9, 2017 and end at 11:59:59 PM EST on October 5, 2017 ("Entry Period").
2. **SPONSOR AND LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS:** The Competition is sponsored by The City of New York Mayor’s Office of Media and Entertainment (“City”) and Musiquarium, Inc. (“Musiquarium”) (collectively, “Sponsors”). Participation is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited or restricted by law. You are responsible for checking applicable laws in your jurisdiction before participating in the Competition to make sure that your participation is legal and to ensure that you comply with all relevant laws.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Competition is open only to residents of the City of New York aged 13-19 at the time of entry. Any participant under the age of 18 (“Minor”) at the time of entry must obtain permission of his/her parent(s)/legal guardian(s) to participate. Employees of the Sponsors and the judges or any of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising agencies, or any other company or individual involved with the design, production, execution or distribution of the Competition and their immediate family (spouse, parents and step-parents, siblings and step-siblings, and children and step-children) and household members (people who share the same residence at least three (3) months out of the year) of each such employee are not eligible to participate or to receive prizes. The Competition is subject to all applicable United States federal, state and local laws and regulations. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.
4. **HOW TO ENTER:** To enter, go to <http://guitarmash.org/mynycsongcontest> (the “Competition Website”) and read the Official Rules. Then, during the Entry Period, use the Competition online entry form to: (1) enter your first name, last name, email address, and song title, and all other required fields on the online entry form; (2) upload your song, and a copy of the written lyrics (collectively, your “Entry”). Entry must include a guitar or ukulele and voice, and can feature up to two people.

Entry must be an original song about or inspired by New York City and can range from being about particular neighborhoods and their respective communities, to parks, modes of transportation and monuments. Entries may also be about or inspired by specific features of the city that have a particular significance to you. Entries should convey qualities of New York City that make the city a unique and an exciting place to live and create. You should consider the quality of the recording and artistic composition, and should make sure that the Entry appeals to a broad audience community.

Entries must be comprised only of original elements created by you and may not contain elements which are/have been created, developed, copyrighted, trademarked and/or patented by third parties (including, without limitation, music, and lyrics) or which are owned or subject to proprietary or licensing rights of or by an entity other than you. Entries must not include the name or likeness of any individual other than you, unless such individual has granted express permission to be included in the Entry, and must not include a minor, unless written permission has been obtained from his or her parent or legal guardian. Sponsors reserve the right to request third party releases from any third party included in any Entry at any time. Failure to produce fully executed third party releases, if applicable, may result in disqualification of the Entry, in Sponsors' sole and absolute discretion. Each Entry must comply with the Guidelines & Restrictions set forth herein.

To submit your Entry, you must electronically acknowledge and agree to the terms of these Official Rules and the Competition Website's Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. In the event of a conflict between these Official Rules and the Competition Website's Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, the terms of these Official Rules shall prevail. You must have a valid email address to enter. In the event of a dispute over who submitted a winning Entry, the authorized subscriber of the email account used to participate in this Competition at the actual time of Entry will be deemed to be the "Entrant". The authorized account subscriber is defined as the natural person who is assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization (e.g. business, education, institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. No automated entry devices and/or programs permitted. All Entries become the property of the Sponsors and will not be acknowledged or returned.

Entries must meet the Guidelines & Restrictions set forth below. Entries must be received within the Entry Period. Entries that have been tampered with or altered, or that are false, incomplete, lost, late, illegible, stolen, incomplete, invalid, misdirected, technically corrupted, or garbled, are void. Only fully completed entry forms are eligible. Proof of submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Sponsors.

There is no limitation on the number of Entries you may submit. However, each Entrant may only have one (1) Entry as a winning Entry or Finalist. This means that

only one Winner or Finalist position is available to you regardless of your number of Entries.

5. **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES AND CONTENT RESTRICTIONS:** By submitting an Entry, you represent and warrant that the Entry conforms to the Submission Guidelines and Content Restrictions as defined below (“Guidelines & Restrictions”). You acknowledge and agree that Sponsors, in their sole discretion, may remove any Entry and disqualify you from the Competition if they believe, in their sole discretion, that your Entry fails to conform to the Guidelines & Restrictions:

(a) Submission Guidelines:

1. The song uploaded in the Entry must be no longer than five (5) minutes in length.
2. The song must be uploaded in .mp3 format, file size not to exceed 5mb.
3. The written lyrics must be uploaded as a PDF.

(b) Content Restrictions:

1. The Entry must not contain material that violates or infringes upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property rights of any person or entity, or that triggers any payment, reporting or royalty obligation to any third party;
2. The Entry must not contain material that is, in the Sponsors’ sole judgment, obscene, offensive, defamatory, trade libelous, or inappropriate for a general audience that may include minors;
3. The Entry must not contain references to gang signs or symbols, violence, nudity, illegal drug or firearm use;
4. The Entry must not contain references to commercial products or establishments (e.g., clothing, toys, food, stores, restaurants, etc.) and/or their trademarks, brands, logos or endorsements;
5. The Entry must not contain malicious code, such as viruses, timebombs, cancelbots, worms, Trojan horses or other potentially harmful programs or other material or information;
6. The Entry must not contain any material that violates any applicable law, statute, ordinance, rule or regulation; and
7. The Entry must not violate any of the terms or conditions of the Official Rules.

You acknowledge that other Entrants may have used ideas and/or concepts in their Entries that may be similar in idea and/or concept to what is included in your Entry, and you understand and agree that you shall not have any claim against any other entrant or Sponsors arising out of any such similarity or be entitled to any compensation because of any such similarity.

6. **JUDGING PERIOD:** The Judging Period will begin at 9:00:00 AM EST on October 6, 2017 and end at 11:59:00 AM EST on October 22, 2017. All Entries will be judged based on the Judging Criteria set forth below, in the sole discretion of a panel of judges that have the required knowledge and experience to apply the Judging Criteria.
 - a. appeal of the song concept and subject matter;
 - b. overall quality of the song; and
 - c. interpretation of the New York City theme.
7. **WINNER:** The Entry that receives the highest overall scores from Judges during the Judging Period will be a potential Winner. In the event of a tie, the Winner will be selected based on the criteria described in (a), then (b), and finally (c).
8. **WINNER SELECTION:** ALL POTENTIAL WINNERS ARE SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION BY THE SPONSORS WHOSE DECISIONS ARE FINAL AND BINDING IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE COMPETITION. A potential Winner will be notified via email on or about October 23, 2017 using the contact information provided in the potential Winner's Entry. The potential Winner (and his/her parent or legal guardian, if a Minor) will be asked to complete an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability/Publicity Release, and/or rights transfer document, and, if applicable, a release from any and all third parties appearing in the potential Winner's Entry, within five (5) days of notification. If, after five (5) days of notification, the potential Winner does not respond to Sponsors' notice or does not return the aforementioned documents, that potential Winner will be disqualified. Return of any notification email as "undeliverable" or failure to fully comply with these Official Rules will result in disqualification. In the event of disqualification of any potential Winner, the prize will be forfeited by that potential Winner and the Entry with the next highest score among the Finalists (defined in Section 9 below) will be selected as a potential Winner in his or her place. Sponsors are not responsible for notifications that are misdirected, addresses that are no longer correct, or for any other inability to contact the potential Winner beyond the control of Sponsors.

The potential Winner may be required to pass a background check (the "Background Check") to Sponsors' satisfaction in their sole discretion. Any Background Check will take place after the potential winner is notified of his or her selection as a potential Winner. The potential Winner must be available to attend the Guitar Mash at City Winery on Sunday, November 19, 2017 ("Guitar Mash"), as well as a rehearsal on Saturday, November 18, 2017. If a potential Winner fails any such Background Check or is unavailable to attend the Guitar Mash or rehearsal, Sponsors reserve the right to disqualify such potential Winner and select the Entry with the next highest score among the Finalists as a new potential Winner.

Sponsors reserve the right to modify the number of potential Winners or not select a Winner if Sponsors determine, in their sole and absolute discretion, that Entries

received did not meet the minimum qualification standards based on the Guidelines & Restrictions and the Judging Criteria specified herein or if there are an insufficient number of eligible Entries. To the extent permitted by law, Sponsors disclaim any liability from, and you, whether or not selected as a potential Winner or Finalist, agree to waive any claims against Sponsors relating to the judging or awarding process. The final determination of the Winner and the application of the Judging Criteria shall be in the sole and absolute discretion of Sponsors.

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY A POTENTIAL WINNER (AT THE SPONSORS'S SOLE DISCRETION) WILL RESULT IN SUCH POTENTIAL WINNER'S DISQUALIFICATION AS A WINNER OF THE COMPETITION AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS A WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED. Upon disqualification for any reason, a potential Winner's prize will be forfeited and no compensation will be given.

9. **FINALISTS:** Up to two (2) additional Entries will be designated as Finalists by the judges. Each Finalist (and his/her parent or guardian, if a Minor) will be asked to provide contact information and sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability/Publicity Release, and/or rights transfer document, and, if applicable, a release from any and all third parties appearing in the Finalist's Entry, within five (5) days of notification. If, after five (5) days of notification, the Finalist does not respond to Sponsors' notice or does not return the aforementioned documents, that Finalist may be disqualified and the Entry with the next highest score may be selected as a new Finalist. The final determination of the Finalists and the application of the Judging Criteria shall be in the sole and absolute discretion of Sponsors.
10. **THE PRIZES:** After the Winner has been confirmed, Guitar Mash will announce the Winner and the other Finalists on the Competition Website, where the finalist songs and the names of the Finalists and Winner will be displayed. Sponsors reserve the right to delay the announcement of the Winner in their sole discretion.

The Winner will receive the following "Grand Prize":

a recording session, on a date to be mutually agreed upon by Winner and Sponsor, which will include a minimum of two hours with a producer/technician provided by Sponsor resulting in a digital recording of the Winner's song; a performance spot in Guitar Mash at City Winery on November 19, 2017 (the "Event"), as well as two VIP tickets for guests to attend the Event. The Grand Prize has an approximate retail value of \$1,500.00. The Winner may have his or her song title and name displayed, as well as a non-downloadable recording of the song available to listen to, on the Competition Website at the discretion of and pursuant to terms to be determined by the Sponsors. The Winner's song may also be featured on official social media channels operated by the Sponsors.

Up to two (2) Finalists each will receive the following "First Prize": a recording session on a date to be mutually agreed upon by each Finalist and Sponsor, which

will include a minimum of two hours each with a producer/technician provided by Sponsor resulting in a digital recording of the Finalists' songs, and two VIP tickets to attend the Event. The First Prize has an approximate retail value of \$1,500.00. The Finalists may have their song titles and names displayed, as well as non-downloadable recordings of the songs available to listen to, on the Competition Website at the discretion of and pursuant to terms to be determined by the Sponsors. The Finalists' songs may also be featured on official social media channels operated by the Sponsors.

The terms and conditions of the VIP tickets awarded will govern if the Event does not take place due to weather, an act of God, threat or act of terrorism, civil disturbance or any other reason. Event tickets are subject to certain terms and conditions. Seat locations will be determined by the Sponsors. The Released Entities (defined below), and/or any other relevant party, reserve the right to remove or to deny entry to any Winner or guest who engages in a disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person at the Event. Cash cannot be substituted for any ticket prize unless otherwise agreed by the Sponsors. Unused tickets cannot be refunded, exchanged for cash or applied towards tickets for any subsequent years. No responsibility is assumed by the Released Entities for any cancelled, rescheduled, delayed or postponed Event. Certain restrictions, as determined by the Sponsors, may apply. All specifics of the event will be at the Sponsors' discretion. If a Winner or Finalist cannot comply with these restrictions or any other portion of these Official Rules, or cannot participate for any reason, the prize will be forfeited in its entirety and an alternate Winner or Finalist will be chosen from among the Entrants. No substitutions or cash redemptions. In the case of unavailability of any prize, Sponsors reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All costs and expenses associated with prize acceptance and use not listed herein as part of the prize including, without limitation, ground transportation and gratuities, are the sole responsibility of the Winner and Finalists. All federal, state and local income taxes on the prizes, if any, are solely the responsibility of the Winner and Finalists.

11. **OWNERSHIP OF ENTRIES:** The Sponsors do not claim any ownership rights in any material contained in your Entry. By submitting an Entry, you agree to grant the Sponsors (and any and all of the Sponsors' affiliates, subsidiaries, parents, successors, assignees and licensees) the non-exclusive, fully paid-up and royalty-free, worldwide irrevocable right and license, but not the obligation, to modify, publicly perform, reproduce, broadcast, copy, encode, compress, encrypt, incorporate data into, transmit, record, synchronize and translate your Entry, including without limitation the right to distribute all or part of your Entry in any manner, an unlimited number of times, in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised for any purpose, in perpetuity.

Sponsors may use the Entries to advertise, promote and publicize the Competition, the Sponsors and/or any other of Sponsor's websites in any and all media throughout the universe and may authorize others to do so; such advertising, promotion and

publicity may include portions, excerpts, and/or modified versions of the Entries. You acknowledge that Sponsors may use your Entry in accordance with the permission granted herein without any payment to you or any third party.

By submitting an Entry, you or, if you are a Minor, your parent(s)/legal guardian(s), consent to the use, by the Sponsors, their affiliates, subsidiaries, parents, and licensees, of your name, likeness, image, photograph, voice, and biographical information in connection with the Competition-related marketing activities of the Sponsors, in any media or format now known or hereafter invented, in any and all locations, without any payment to or further approval from you, except where prohibited by law. You agree that this consent is perpetual and cannot be revoked.

You acknowledge that the Competition is not sponsored by, endorsed by, administered by, or associated with any social media platform, and that your Entry is being submitted to the Sponsors. You agree that nothing in these Official Rules grants you a right or license to use any Sponsors' trademark or service mark.

12. **RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION:** By entering the Competition, you agree to: (a) comply with and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsors and/or the Competition judges which are binding and final in all matters relating to this Competition; (b) release and hold harmless the Sponsors and their respective parent, subsidiary, and affiliated companies, the prize suppliers and any other organizations responsible for sponsoring, fulfilling, administering, advertising or promoting the Competition, and all of their respective past and present officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives (collectively, the "Released Parties") from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liability, including but not limited to negligence and damages of any kind to persons and property, including but not limited to invasion of privacy (under appropriation, intrusion, public disclosure of private facts, false light in the public eye or other legal theory), defamation, slander, libel, violation of right of publicity, infringement of trademark, copyright or other intellectual property rights, property damage, or death or personal injury arising out of or relating to your Entry (including its creation or submission), participation in the Competition, acceptance or use or misuse of prize (including any travel or activity related thereto) and/or the broadcast, transmission, performance, exploitation or use of Entry; (c) indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liabilities (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or relating to your participation in the Competition and/or your acceptance, use or misuse of any prize; and (d) acknowledge compliance with these Official Rules.

13. **REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES:** In submitting an Entry into the Competition, you agree, confirm and represent to the Sponsors that neither you nor anyone else to your knowledge has engaged or taken part in (or induced or encouraged anyone else to do so) any activity or conduct in connection with the Competition that: (i) may or is likely to harm or create a risk of harm, physical or mental injury, emotional distress, death, disability, disfigurement, or physical or

mental illness to any person, other living thing or any property; (ii) may or is likely to create a risk of any other loss or damage to person, living things or property; (iii) is or may constitute a crime, unlawful or non-consensual activities (*e.g.*, conduct that could lead to criminal prosecution), tortious conduct (*e.g.*, conduct that could lead to civil prosecution) or the violation or infringement of the rights of any other party; or (iv) violates any of the terms or conditions of these Official Rules. You further represent and warrant that: (v) the Entry is your own original work; (vi) you are the sole and exclusive owner of all of the content contained in the Entry; (vii) you have all the rights to the content of the Entry and all components thereof; (viii) you have obtained all rights, consents and permissions, including but not limited to those of all living persons participating/referenced in the Entry, necessary to grant the rights granted herein; and (ix) the rights that you are granting under these Official Rules do not conflict in any way with any other agreement to which you are a party, or with any commitments, restrictions, or obligations that you are under to any other person or entity. You agree to obtain, upon request of any of the Sponsors, any documentation and releases necessary to prove your unrestricted ownership in all materials contained in your Entry. Noncompliance with any requirement in connection with the Competition, including, without limitation, any deadlines set forth by the Sponsors, will result in your disqualification.

14. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** The Sponsors reserve the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Competition, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the Sponsors' reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Competition, as determined by the Sponsors in its sole discretion. The Sponsors reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual or Entrant it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Competition or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Sponsors reserve the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Sponsors' failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. If, for any reason, the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including, without limitation, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Sponsors which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition or for any reason that Sponsors deem it necessary, Sponsors reserve the right in their sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition, and to determine the Winner and Finalists from all eligible Entries received prior to and/or after (if appropriate) the action taken by Sponsors, in their sole discretion.

15. **ANCILLARY FOOTAGE BY THE CITY:** The City may record additional footage and ancillary material at the Event, including the Winner's performance of his or her winning Entry song, which may be produced in association with

Musiquarium (“Programming”). The City shall be the exclusive owner of the copyright and other rights in and to the Programming. The City will be able to use the Programming forever and throughout the world, and to license others to use it, in any manner the City wishes and in any and all media now known or hereafter discovered or developed without notice, including for advertising, promoting and publicizing any of its services or the City of New York. Such use may include portions and excerpts, in addition to modified versions of the Programming. By participating in this Competition, you acknowledge that the City may use the Programming in accordance with the permissions you granted herein without any compensation, royalty, payment, liability or obligation to you, whether or not you are selected as a Winner, or to any third party. The City is under no obligation to broadcast or otherwise exploit the Programming.

16. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The Released Parties are not responsible for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by Entrants, printing errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Competition; (2) technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited to malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections in phone lines or network hardware or software; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Competition; (4) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Competition or receipt or use of any prize. If your Entry is confirmed to have been erroneously deleted, lost, or otherwise destroyed or corrupted, your sole remedy is to another provide another Entry. No more than the stated number of prizes will be awarded. The liability of the Released Parties for any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs you incurred, including costs associated with entering this Competition, but in no event attorneys’ fees. Under no circumstances will you be permitted to obtain awards for, and you hereby waive all rights to claim, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, arising out of your access to and use of the Competition Website and/or entry in the Competition, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. Without limiting the foregoing, this Competition and all prizes are provided “as is” without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, or non-infringement. **SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR EXCLUSION OF IMPLIED WARRANTIES, SO SOME OF THE ABOVE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. CHECK YOUR LOCAL LAWS FOR ANY RESTRICTIONS REGARDING THESE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSIONS.**

17. DISPUTES: You agree that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Competition, or any prizes awarded, other than those concerning the administration of the Competition or the determination of winners, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (2) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected

with this Competition, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved exclusively by the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, or the appropriate state court for New York County, New York. You waive any and all objections to jurisdiction and venue in other courts and hereby submits to the jurisdiction of New York Courts. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the Entrant and Sponsors in connection with the Competition, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of New York or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of New York.

Any attempt by any individual to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, Sponsors reserve the right to seek damages from any such individual to the fullest extent permitted by law.

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY THE WINNERS OR FINALISTS OR ANY BEHAVIOR BY THE WINNERS OR FINALISTS THAT WILL BRING SUCH WINNERS, FINALISTS OR SPONSORS INTO DISREPUTE (AS DETERMINED BY SPONSORS IN THEIR SOLE DISCRETION) WILL RESULT IN SUCH WINNER'S OR FINALIST'S DISQUALIFICATION AND ALL PRIVILEGES WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.

18. **PRIVACY:** Sponsors collect personal information from you when you enter the Competition. The information collected is subject to the privacy policy located at <http://guitarmash.org/privacy-policy/>. By participating in the Competition, you hereby agree to Sponsors' collection and usage of your personal information and you acknowledge that you have read and accepted the foregoing privacy policy. Notwithstanding the foregoing, your use of the Competition Website does not waive any rights as to the collection, use, disclosure and storage of your personal information under the Communications Act, Federal Trade Commission Act, and any other state and federal statutes, and Sponsors shall only share your personal information with third parties if: (i) the law requires them to do so; (ii) it is needed to protect Sponsor's own property or the property of Sponsor's affiliates; or (iii) in the event of a corporate restructuring.
